The Sydney Opera house is one of the most iconic roof images in the world. An architectural treasure but a roofing nightmare. Roof designs can be fun, roofing, not so much. “An Eye on the Details” addresses four common conditions that routinely provide installation issues during construction. This course provides visual examples of actual field conditions, some good, some not so good; along with design suggestions that can cut installation costs and reduce construction change orders. Upon completion of this course, you will have a better understanding of the requirements the roofing contractor must meet to provide the specified roofing system warranty, and long term value to the owner.
